

TAP at a glance

TAP is the European leg of the **Southern Gas Corridor** which transports gas from the Azerbaijani sector of the Caspian Sea to Europe.

- It holds strategic importance for Europe's energy security.
- It provides reliable access to a new source of natural gas while supporting the EU's energy transition goals.
- It covers approximately 18% of natural gas imports in Greece, 16% in Italy, and meets the needs of Bulgaria through the IGB.
